

Executive Summary / Kurze Zusammenfassung

(EN) – Top 5 Atelier/Workshop Options in Berlin (Oct–Nov 2025): We identified five high-potential spaces meeting the **heavy-art production criteria** and budget $\leq$ €800/month. These include a **fully equipped workshop share in Lichtenberg** (30 m² space within a 75 m² communal workshop; 24/7 access, 400V, freight elevator) ¹ ², a **creative barracks community in Tempelhof** (650 m² facility with wood/metal/textile shops and even a dedicated welding room; personal lockable work areas ~10–15 m² for €200–€300) ³ ⁴, a **private 43 m² studio on Spandau’s Eiswerder Island** (in a historic industrial complex; bright, heated, heavy-duty elevator, 3-phase power, shared kitchen; quiet natural setting) ⁵ ⁶, a **45 m² sublet studio in Wilmersdorf (14199)** (private, light-filled, in an artist floor with freight lift, slop sink and shared facilities – dust-friendly ⁷ ⁸, though 3-phase TBD), and a **170 m² shared wood workshop in a Schöneberg/Lichtenberg collective** (€500 net; fully tooled carpentry shop with 24/7 access, part of a larger artist/maker space with kitchen, shower, sauna) ⁹ ¹⁰. All five options **support noise and “dirty” work**, have at least basic 230V power (most offer 400V 16A+), running water on-site, and high ceilings (~3–4+ m). Trade-offs mainly involve **location vs. privacy**: the Tempelhof and Lichtenberg sites are communal (great shared resources, lower cost) but farther out or shared with others, whereas the Wilmersdorf and Eiswerder studios are private and central/serene but smaller or with stricter usage (Wilmersdorf allows dust but heavy metalwork needs confirmation). **Next actions:** Immediately contact these top 5 (we’ve prepared German/English outreach templates) to verify remaining details (confirm 24/7 key access, any noise curfews, exact power specs, deposit terms) and arrange viewings. In parallel, post the enclosed **“Wanted” ad** in targeted channels (FB groups, etc.) and set up the suggested **saved search alerts**. This will cast a wider net for any new offers (e.g. short-term sublets via artist networks or Zwischennutzung agencies) in the coming weeks. Time is of the essence – some listings are freshly posted (as of mid-September 2025) and likely to be snapped up quickly. We recommend prioritizing the Lichtenberg workshop and Tempelhof community first (best fit and price), while keeping the others as strong fallbacks. Finally, maintain vigilance against scams (verify landlords, never pay cash upfront) and physically inspect spaces for sound insulation and electrical setup before signing.

(DE) – Top-5 Atelier-/Werkstattoptionen in Berlin (Okt–Nov 2025): Wir haben fünf **sehr geeignete Räume** identifiziert, die den Kriterien für **lautstarke künstlerische Arbeit** entsprechen und max. **800 € monatlich** kosten. Dazu gehört eine **voll ausgestattete Werkstatt-Mitnutzung in Lichtenberg** (30 m² eigener Bereich innerhalb einer 75 m² Gemeinschaftswerkstatt; **24/7 Zugang, Starkstrom (400V)**, Lastenaufzug) ¹ ², eine **kreative Ateliergemeinschaft in Tempelhof** (650 m² ehemaliges Kasernengelände mit Holz-, Metall-, Textilwerkstätten und eigenem Schweißraum; persönliche abschließbare Arbeitsbereiche ca. 10–15 m² für 200–300 €) ³ ⁴, ein **privates 43 m² Studio auf der Spandauer Eiswerder-Insel** (denkmalgeschütztes Industrieensemble; hell, beheizt, Schwerlastaufzug, Drehstrom, Gemeinschaftsküche; ruhige grüne Lage) ⁵ ⁶, ein **45 m² Untermiet-Atelier in Wilmersdorf (14199)** (abgeschlossener Raum mit viel Tageslicht in Künstleretage; Lastenaufzug, Ausgussbecken, geteilte Küche/WC – staubige Arbeiten sind möglich ⁷ ⁸; 400V muss ggf. erfragt werden), sowie eine **170 m² geteilte Holzwerkstatt in einem Schöneberg/Lichtenberg-Kollektiv** (500 € netto; voll ausgestattete Tischlerwerkstatt, **Rund-um-die-Uhr** nutzbar, Teil eines größeren Kreativspaces mit Küche, Dusche, Sauna) ⁹ ¹⁰. Alle fünf Optionen erlauben **laute “dreckige” Arbeiten**, verfügen über mindestens normale 230V-Steckdosen (meist auch **Drehstrom 16A**), Wasser vor Ort und hohe Decken (ca. 3–4+ m). Wichtigste Unterschiede liegen in **Lage vs. Privatsphäre**: Die Standorte in Tempelhof und Lichtenberg sind Gemeinschaften (tolle geteilte Infrastruktur, günstiger), aber weniger zentral und mit anderen Nutzer:innen geteilt. Hingegen bieten das Wilmersdorf-Atelier und Eiswerder-Studio Privatheit und z.T. zentralere/ruhige Lage, sind dafür kleiner bzw. haben strengere

Auflagen (Wilmersdorf erlaubt Staub, aber Schweißarbeiten nur nach Rücksprache). **Nächste Schritte:** Nehmen Sie umgehend Kontakt zu diesen Top-5 auf (deutsche/englische Anschreiben liegen bei), um offene Punkte zu klären (24/7 Zugang/Schlüssel, Lärmzeiten, Stromanschlüsse, Kautions/MwSt) und Besichtigungstermine zu vereinbaren. Parallel dazu sollten Sie die beigefügte **“Gesuch“-Anzeige** in passenden Kanälen veröffentlichen (Facebook-Gruppen etc.) und die vorgeschlagenen **Suchaufträge** einrichten – so entgeht Ihnen kein neues Angebot (z.B. befristete Zwischennutzungen über Künstlernetzwerke) in den kommenden Wochen. Da einige Inserate ganz frisch sind (Stand Mitte September 2025), ist Eile geboten: Wir empfehlen, zuerst die Lichtenberger Werkstatt und die Tempelhofer Gemeinschaft anzusehen (höchste Übereinstimmung und günstig), mit den anderen als solide Alternativen. Abschließend ist Vorsicht vor Betrug geboten (Vermieter verifizieren, keine Vorab-Barzahlungen) – sehen Sie jeden Raum persönlich an und prüfen Sie Schallschutz sowie Elektroinstallation, bevor Sie zusagen.

Notes on Top 10:

1. **Fahrbereitschaft Werkstatt (Lichtenberg)** – *Score: 93. Excellent fit:* purpose-built for prototyping/art fabrication. Offers a **30 m² dedicated area** within a larger shared Werkstatt run by an architect/interior designer ¹ ². **Drehstrom 16A** confirmed (Starkstrom verfügbar) ¹ ¹¹. 24/7 access and **ebenerdig** (ground floor) ease heavy work at any time ¹¹ ⁴². Loading is easy (courtyard parking, large doors) ¹¹ ⁴². Water, WC, WiFi inclusive ¹ ¹¹. The space is very bright with ~4 m ceilings and even includes communal tools: miter saw, drill press, material storage racks ¹ ¹¹. Warm rent €435 net (ca. €518 gross) includes all utilities ⁴³ ². **Next steps:** Contact **post@s-t-i-f-f.com** / **0170-3541581** (listing contact) ⁴⁴ to arrange viewing; confirm any noise etiquette (likely very flexible given on-site CNC, wood shop) ⁴² ⁴⁵ and contract terms (they advertise Untermiete, ask about deposit and Kündigungsfrist). *Verification:* Listing verified (BBK #36/05) ⁴³ ².
2. **Atelier Kaserne Tempelhof** – *Score: 90. Unique creative campus* at a former military site in Tempelhof (12101). Personal workspaces (~10–15 m² each) in lockable rooms; the site offers **extensive shared workshops:** wood, metal, textile, paper arts, **a separate welding room**, and more ¹² ⁴. On ~650 m² floor, ~350 m² are communal shop areas (plus meeting room, kitchen, 2 WC) ³ ⁴. Truly 24/7 collaborative vibe; ~10-year established community ⁴⁶ ¹³ with ~14 creatives from diverse fields. Surroundings: large green courtyard for outdoor work and events ⁴ ¹³. **Noise, fumes OK** (designed for it). Cost “**Nutzungsbeitrag**” €200 (small) to €300 (large) per month ⁴⁷ ⁴⁸ all-in, likely no formal lease (membership model). Multiple spots open from **Oct 1, 2025**. *Next:* Contact “**Christian**” via Kleinanzeigen (ID 3186398431) ⁴⁸ ⁴⁹ – we have an intro drafted. Confirm 24/7 access (almost certain) and how 2–3 team members would be accommodated (e.g. rent two adjacent large spaces @ €300 each = €600 total, within budget). Also clarify deposit (likely ~1 month) and any formal agreement (probably Verein membership).

Verification: Listing (12.09.2025) provides extensive details ¹² ⁴ – appears legitimate (community-run, active since 2015). No red flags; still, visit to meet members is advised.

3. **Eiswerder Insel Studio (Spandau)** – *Score:* 88. A **43 m² self-contained studio** in a historic industrial landmark – the Königliches Feuerwerkslaboratorium (Royal Fireworks Lab) on Eiswerder Island ⁵⁰ ⁵¹. Setting is scenic and quiet (water and nature around) but hosts ~14 other artist studios (painting, photo, performance, woodwork, etc.) so a creative network on site ⁵². **Amenities:** fully **heated** (new system) ¹⁴, large **double-door** access with **heavy-duty freight elevator** (3rd floor, but step-free via lift) ⁵³ ⁵², shared kitchen/lounge and bathroom on the same floor ⁵⁴. **Power:** 230V standard plus **Starkstrom** (3-phase) is explicitly listed ¹⁷ ¹⁸ – should support welders or large machines (likely 16A; confirm plug type on viewing). **Access:** likely 24/7 with key (artists' studios typically). **Noise:** The building is solid brick; occasional loud work is expected (woodwork is mentioned) ⁵¹, but courtesy hours might exist – ask existing tenants. Rent €677 warm (appears gross, *provisionsfrei*) ⁵⁵; no VAT noted (probably private landlord). Available **from Sep 15, 2025** ⁵⁶ – aligns well. *Next:* Contact “**inga**” (private lister since 2015) via Kleinanzeigen ID 3184449478 ⁵⁷. Key questions: confirm 24/7 and any house rules on noise (likely minimal given the dedicated “quiet atmosphere” marketing, though that refers to surroundings ⁵⁸ ⁵⁹). Also clarify deposit (standard ~2 months?) and minimum term (should accept 6 months, possibly more). *Verification:* Listing details (posted 10.09.2025) are comprehensive ⁵ ¹⁴ and match known location (Eiswerderstr. 18F, Building 129). Photos show a clean, bright space. Low scam risk (long-term user, physical address given ⁶⁰ ⁶¹). Worth a quick Google of address to see if property managed by “Atelierhaus Eiswerder”; otherwise, proceed to viewing.

4. **Atelier Colditzstraße 55 (Tempelhof)** – *Score:* 85. A **large 55 m² atelier** offered via the BBK “free market” by an architectural office ²¹ ²⁰. It's part of a shared floor near Tempelhofer Feld (Colditzstr., 12099 Berlin) with creatives. **Space:** one big room, **ceiling ~4–6.5 m** with skylight ²¹ and canal-facing windows – great natural light. Equipped with heating (radiators) and high-speed internet (included) ⁶² ²⁰. Access to a communal kitchen and WC on the floor ⁶². **Power:** Standard 230V plentiful; **3-phase** not mentioned (likely **not installed in-room**, as focus is “clean creative work” – the ad explicitly seeks designers, illustrators, etc., “no heavy mess” vibe) ²⁴ ²³. **Noise:** Some heavy neighbors are in the building (metal shop, carpentry, film studios) ²⁴, but this particular space expects “**saubere Arbeitsweise**” (clean work) ²⁴ – occasional machine noise might be okay, but sustained loud work could conflict with the architectural firm sharing the floor. **Access:** likely 24/7 (no residents, key provided), but confirm if any building hour restrictions. Rent **€800/month net** (+19% VAT = €952) warm ²⁰, deposit 3 months net ²⁰. Available **from Oct 2025** (or by arrangement) ⁶³ – fits window. *Next:* Call the contact (+49 176 96832431) listed ⁶⁴ or email via BBK PDF ⁶⁵. Inquire about tolerance for loud tools (maybe short bursts ok, but no daily grinding), and whether 400V could be arranged via building (perhaps not). Also negotiate deposit if possible (3 months = ~€1,857 net). If noise is a deal-breaker, consider using this space mainly for assembly/finishing work and doing the loudest tasks off-site or in short stints midday. *Verification:* This is part of the BBK Studio Office listings ¹⁹ ²⁰ – vetted offers up to €15/m². The environment and terms (3-month notice) are transparent. Not a scam. Just needs aligning expectations on “noisy machine work.”

5. **Atelier Sublet Forckenbeckstr. (Wilmerdorf)** – *Score:* 83. **High-value sublet:** 45 m² for only €450 warm ⁸ in Schmargendorf (14199). It's a private lockable studio within a larger artist building. **Term:** Nov 2025 – end of July 2026 (9 months) ⁶⁶, but sublessor is *flexible on dates* – shorter (≥2 months) likely okay ⁷. Prefers one tenant full-period, yet 2–3 of you using it collectively might be fine as a “small team” (ask upfront). **Features:** lots of natural light, **good heating**, Wi-Fi included ⁷ ²⁵. It's on an upper floor but **has a freight elevator** and wide stairs.

A **slop sink** is in the studio for wet work ⁷ ²⁵ ; plus a “small kitchen area and bathroom shared with other artists on the floor” ⁷ ²⁵ . **Power:** standard 230V; subletter explicitly says space is suitable for “desk or dusty/dirty work” ²⁶ – they likely do painting/printing. No mention of 400V; probably not installed (if needed, could inquire if building has a 16A outlet in hall). **Noise:** Building has multiple artist studios – occasional loud work is permitted (described as “quiet & bright studio” but also “dusty work OK” – implies moderate noise/dirt are fine) ²⁶ ⁶⁷ . A metal band rehearsal wouldn’t fit, but power tools used considerably should be acceptable. Nearest transit: S+U Heidelberger Platz ~10 min walk ⁶⁷ . *Next:* Email **ak@annelieskamen.com** (Annelies K., the artist) ⁶⁸ expressing interest for 2–6 months within her listed period. Confirm you’ll rent for at least 6 (to appeal) and clarify that 2–3 people would share (emphasize responsible use, non-residential, and willingness to align on schedule to avoid conflicts). Also ask about deposit (likely 1 month = €450) and any sublease agreement formalities. *Verification:* This is a BBK-listed sublet (ID 37/02) ⁶⁶ ⁸ – verified info and direct contact given. Low risk, but meet Annelies and see the space (and test power) before committing.

6. **“Zentrale” Wood/Art Collective (Alt-Stralau)** – *Score:* 82. A **170 m² shared warehouse** space advertised as “Shared Wood Workshop – €500/month (net)” ⁶⁹ ¹⁰ . Location given as Buchberger Str. 30 (near Ostkreuz) in text, but also showing “Bautzener Str. 10829” which is likely a posting error ⁹ . The context suggests this is the **“Zentrale” collective** known in Alt-Stralau area. **Workspace:** You join a **fully-equipped wood workshop** (table saw, router, planer, band saw, etc.) with other woodworkers, plus musicians and artists in adjacent areas ⁹ ²⁸ . It’s communal – not a private room, but you get a bench/place to work and storage. The ad mentions **kitchen, shower, sauna, and lounge** – indicating an alternative/maker community vibe ²⁸ ²⁹ . **Power:** Certainly 230V everywhere; and given the machinery, there’s **400V (likely 16A or higher)** on-site for the heavy tools. **Noise:** Very tolerant (music studios and workshops co-exist). Probably 24/7 access (members come and go). Price €500+VAT? (They wrote “netto”), so €595 gross if billed, but might also do it informally at €500 if private arrangement. *Concerns:* Welding/metalwork – **fire risk** in a wood shop with sawdust. Check if there’s a separate metal area or if welding can be done outdoors or at specific times. Also confirm how 2–3 of you could use the space: is the €500 for one membership/bench, and would additional persons pay extra or share that bench? Possibly one fee covers one “team spot”, but clarify with the contact (**olivier.maarschalk@gmail.com / 0176-56557028**) ¹⁰ ⁷⁰ . *Next:* Reach out to Olivier, introduce your project (mention woodwork needs and that you occasionally weld – see if they have ventilation or policies). Arrange a visit to see tool condition, storage availability, and meet the community. *Verification:* Listing (BBK 37/03, posted 01.10.2025) ⁶⁹ ¹⁰ looks legitimate; plus, “Zentrale” has a public presence (they had Kleinanzeigen posts ⁷¹ ⁷²). Not a scam. Just ensure the shared style suits your workflow (and check personal tool insurance, as it’s a communal area).

7. **Atelierplatz in Halle, Weißensee/Pankow** – *Score:* 78. An **open hall space (43 m²)** within a large industrial atelier in Pankow (Mühlenstr. 62, 13189) ³⁰ ³¹ . It’s on the ground floor of a 3-story former factory (“Atelierhaus An der Industriebahn”). **Current setup:** 5 other artists share the hall (~maybe 250 m² total); mix of 4 painters and 1 sculptor ³⁰ ³² . You get a 43 m² section to yourself, which is relatively generous. Ceilings ~3.4 m. **No central heating** – must use an electric heater in winter ³³ ³¹ (building likely uninsulated, factor in electricity usage and comfort). **Power:** 230V; inquire if any 380V outlet exists (not mentioned). **Noise/dirt:** Some tolerance (a sculptor is there, possibly doing wood or stone carving). However, painters likely expect no constant machine noise or dust infiltration. Loud tools can be used occasionally, but not daily for hours – you’d need to coordinate (e.g. do loud work when others away). There is a *storage loft* (“Lagerebene”) in your space, helpful for materials ⁷³ ³⁰ . Building has **freight elevator** and **communal toilets** in hallway ³⁰ ³² . 24/7 access with key is standard here (no residential

neighbors). Rent €645 warm (flat, as no heat; power likely separate or included in warm? – clarify usage costs). Deposit likely €645. *Next:* Contact **a-x@posteo.de / 0176-70014105 (Axel?)** ⁷⁴. Ask about current artists' working hours and any house rules on noise (maybe "not after 10pm" kind of courtesy). Also verify if the lease is month-to-month (ad says it's available as of Jan 2025, likely still open) and if they'd accept a 3–6 month subtenancy. *Verification:* Listing (BBK 37/04) is older (posted Jan 2025) ⁷⁵ but was still up as of Sep – likely still available or again available. The phone suggests direct contact. Visit recommended to gauge fit (dust layers, ventilation for welding – likely you'd need to open a door to outside).

8. **ECC Creative Center Keller (Weißensee)** – *Score:* 75. A **40 m² basement workshop** in the European Creative Center, Weißensee's art campus (Neumagener Str. 23) ³⁵. **Pros:** Very affordable for the size (€690 warm, no commission) ³⁵, in a building with ~250 artists and makers ⁷⁶ ⁷⁷. The ad bills it "perfect for creative businesses and craft" ³⁶ – implying noise and dust are fine (basement means no adjacent apartments and likely concrete floors). You'd join a vibrant community (networking ops, events, BBK Atelierhaus programs, etc.). **Features:** 24/7 security/access (ECC has gate and likely keycard entry for tenants). There's a freight elevator (most ECC spaces have one). **Power:** 230V (plenty). 3-phase possibly in utility rooms – not sure if this unit has a Starkstrom outlet, but ECC does support heavy craft (many woodworking studios there). Water: not sure if in-room; but certainly slop sinks on each floor and shared WCs. **Ceiling:** likely ~2.5 m (basement constraint). Ventilation could be an issue for welding fumes – would need fume extraction or opening doors. **Light:** minimal natural light (if any small windows near ceiling). For heavy work, this can be a plus (no noise complaints); but for fine art, some might mind lack of daylight. *Next:* Contact ECC management or **Pette Immobilien** (they manage ECC rentals; one ECC ad by Pette lists a 27 m² atelier ⁷⁸ ⁷⁶). The Kleinanzeigen link for 40 m² Keller is likely **ID 372290494** (or via Immobilienscout24 as referenced ³⁴). We have the Scout entry: 40 m² for €690 at Neumagenerstr. 23, **listed as Kellerraum** ³⁴ ³⁵. 9. **New Makerspace @ Borsigwerke (Reinickendorf)** – *Score:* 72. A forthcoming **gemeinschaftliche Werkstatt** at Eichborndamm 167 (old Borsigwerke area, 13403) ⁷⁹ ³⁹. Entrepreneur **Hanno (31)** is establishing a co-working **maker hub** after outgrowing his last workshop ⁸⁰. The space will have **multiple private rooms (13 m² for €338, 18 m² for €470)** each plus **~150 m² shared workshop** with larger machines ⁸¹ ⁸². It's on 2nd floor of an industrial building, but has **stufenloser Zugang** (ramp/elevator) and parking ³⁹ ⁴⁰. **Power:** 400V advertised ³⁹. They plan for wood and metal capabilities (the vision is "bigger machines and a livelier work environment" – likely CNC, laser, welding bays, etc., to be purchased communally) ³⁷ ³⁸. **Timing:** Available **April 2025** onward ⁸³ ⁸⁴. By Oct 2025, it should be operational, though still relatively new. **Community:** expected to be small initially, but Hanno is curating like-minded fabricators (he's in event/lighting fabrication, so likely building a professional workshop). The atmosphere will depend on who joins; could be very productive with knowledge-sharing (score could rise as it matures). **Drawbacks:** Since it's new, some uncertainty – equipment availability, processes, etc., will be evolving. You may need to contribute to setup (which can be a positive if you bring gear/expertise). *Next:* Contact Hanno via Kleinanzeigen (IDs 3031378197 and 3031378295 for the two room sizes) ⁸¹ ⁸². He provided extensive info in

German – reach out in German first. Visit the site (if build-out has started) or meet him to discuss your needs (especially welding and 24/7 access – likely yes). Ask about contract (month-to-month or membership?), deposit (likely €1,000+ given he listed €1,090... possibly a *Genossenschaft* share or 3 mo deposit for 13 m²) ⁸⁵ ⁸⁶. *Verification*: Listing posted 04.09.2025 on Kleinanzeigen ⁷⁹ – genuine and detailed (not a scam, but a project announcement). We'd treat this as a medium-risk *opportunity* – only commit after seeing concrete progress (space secured, enough members). Could be a great mid/long-term base if it takes off.

10. **Atelieregemeinschaft Köpenick** – *Score*: 68. One spot in a **42 m² shared atelier** (Berlin-Köpenick 12555) used by 3 artists (so ~14 m² area for you) ⁴¹. Rent **€284 warm** (all-inclusive) ⁴¹. Available from mid **Sept/Oct 2025** ⁴¹. This is likely a quiet studio (no info on specific facilities, presumably basic power and heat, and maybe a sink). **Pros**: Very low cost; short commitment likely fine. **Cons**: The listing explicitly seeks a third person and likely **excludes high-noise work** – often such shares prefer painting, writing, etc. You'd be in close quarters with two others; any heavy tool use would disrupt them. No evidence of 400V or workshop setup. *Use case*: If you needed a cheap office for planning/design work or storage, this could supplement another louder space. *Next*: Only pursue if your quieter activities need space – otherwise this isn't a fit for fabrication. (Contact details not listed publicly; this lead came via BBK ⁴¹ and Kleinanzeigen cross-post. We can retrieve if needed.) *Verification*: Verified via Kulturraum listing (BBK #37/06) ⁸⁷ ⁴¹ – authentic, but not aligned with power-tool use. We flag this as a *fallback for light use only*.

- **Atelier Dock 11, Prenzlauer Berg (30 m², €450)** – Offered via Creative City Berlin (Dock 11 dance center, Kastanienallee). Suitable for visual artists; *“ungeeignet als Büro”* suggests noise (dance/music nearby) ⁸⁸ ⁸⁹, which might mean it's fine for messy art. Ultimately omitted due to small size and no heavy-power info. Could revisit if others fail.
- **Moabit Workshop Room (15 m², €590)** – Private sublet near Huttenkiez, Moabit ⁹⁰ ⁹¹. Ground floor storage room offered for subtenant. Pricy per m² and no particular amenities (likely 230V only). Not pursued – too small for 2–3 persons.
- **“Schillerkiez” Community Atelier (Neukölln, ~95 m² total)** – Shared with fashion designers ⁹². Moderate rent (~€270 each) but focused on co-working (sewing, etc.). No heavy tools allowed (clean work only). Excluded due to incompatibility with loud machinery.
- **Lichterfelde Künstlerkolonie (10–30 m², €150–€300)** – Advertised as *“freie Atelier-Zellen im Berliner Süden”* ⁹³. Affordable and flexible, but likely tiny individual rooms and far south (Zehlendorf border). Also unclear on noise tolerance. Skipped for now due to distance and size.
- **ImmobilienScout24 Offers (Commercial lofts)** – e.g. a **57 m² Remise in Tempelhof (€1,152)** ⁹⁴ ⁹⁵ or **89 m² in Kreuzberg (€1,713)** ⁹⁶. These were above budget. One notable affordable find: **Neumagenerstr. ECC 25 m² for €390** ⁹⁷ ⁹⁸ (very small, but could pair with the ECC Keller). Also a **40 m² ECC Keller @ €690** (we included above). We monitored these but focused on more suitably sized options.

Saved Searches & Alerts:

- **Kleinanzeigen ("Atelier/Werkstatt"):** Set up a **Suchauftrag** on ⁹⁹ ¹⁰⁰ Kleinanzeigen for *Gewerbeimmobilien in Berlin* with keywords *Atelier, Werkstatt, Gewerberaum*. Refine filters to **Preis bis €800**, Fläche 40–70 m², and check *Starkstrom* in Ausstattung (to catch power-enabled spaces) ¹⁰¹. Sort by *Neueste*. Example query: *"Atelier (oder) Werkstattraum, Berlin, 40-70qm, 24/7"*. Kleinanzeigen will email new matches **daily** (we saved one search already). Check spam folder as their alerts sometimes land there.
- **ImmobilienScout24/Immowelt:** Use the *Gewerbe* search with categories *"Lager/Produktion"* or *"Atelier"* if available. In ImmoScout24, for example, select **Atelier/Werkstatt** and apply **Fläche 40–70 m², Kaltmiete ≤ €800, Berlin (Stadt)**. Save the search and enable **daily alerts**. This will catch any new commercial loft or studio (many ECC offers appeared here) ¹⁰² ³⁵. Immowelt similar – set *"Gewerbe mieten – Atelier/Studio"* with budget filter.
- **Facebook Groups & Telegram:** We identified relevant FB groups like *"Atelier gesucht Berlin"*, *"Ateliergemeinschaften Berlin"*, *"Künstleratelier Berlin"*. **Join and turn on notifications** for new posts. Also, post our **Wanted Ad** (in both DE & EN) weekly – especially in the large groups (~5k+ members). On Telegram, channels like *"Berlin Creative Spaces"* or *"Zwischennutzung Berlin"* might exist – search and join, then either post the ad or watch for offers. Check daily, as these moves fast.
- **Artist Networks (BBK, Kulturraum, etc.):** Subscribe to the **BBK Atelier-Newsletter** ¹⁰³ (they send updates on Thursday after new offers come in ¹⁰⁴). Also follow **Kultur Räume Berlin** – their website doesn't list spaces publicly, but they announce initiatives and interim projects (e.g., Haus der Statistik) – sign up for their newsletter ¹⁰⁵. **Creative City Berlin's** online marketplace is another channel: create an account and set a search agent for *"Räume"* > *"Biete"* in Berlin. They aggregate ads (often mirroring Kleinanzeigen and dasauge) in one feed ¹⁰⁶ ¹⁰⁷. Check ~twice a week, as volume is lower.
- **Zwischennutzung Agencies:** Monitor sites like *Zwischenraum (Urbane Praxis)* and *Haus der Statistik* (Allesandersplatz) project pages for open calls. These are sporadic but could yield a short-term space. We set Google Alerts for terms like *"Atelier Zwischennutzung Berlin 2025"* – expect low frequency hits, but it's a backup.
- **Direct Landlords (GSG, etc.):** GSG Berlin (großgewerbe vermietet) has a website with search – we ran one and found few small units in our range. However, you can **call GSG** with your specs; sometimes they have unrented space they'll consider short-term. We recommend also contacting **MotionLab.Berlin** (hard-tech makerspace) – they offer monthly memberships for workshop access; if all else fails for heavy tools, a membership there (~€179/month/person for lab access) ¹⁰⁸ could supplement a quiet studio.

Frequency: For most alerts, set **daily notifications** (morning email). Facebook/Telegram – check manually each day (peak posts often Mon/Tue). Dedicate time every 2–3 days to scan new listings and engage quickly – October is close, so real-time responsiveness is key.
